The aim of VV-ECMO in adult patients is to provide oxygenation and rest the lungs, decreasing the insult caused by mechanical ventilation. Hence, VV-ECMO should be considered as an alternative

to conventional therapy for adults with ARDS and patients with graft dysfunction after lung transplantation 5 (Fig. 2). VV-ECMO has a lower risk of thromboembolic complications and lung perfusion allows endocrine pulmonary function in comparison with VA-ECMO.

Extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) is used for both cardiac and pulmonary failure when conventional measures are no longer substantial in supporting life. ECMO is not a permanent device. It is used as a temporary measure to allow the lungs and heart, as

well as other organs to recover.

On balance, we believe that ECMO benefits those who fail to respond to conventional care (eg, PaO₂ /FiO₂ consistently less than 70 mmHg) and that ECMO should be used early in the course rather than as rescue therapy; thus, adult patients with severe acute respiratory failure should be referred to an ECMO center for consideration of ECMO early in the course of their disease (eg, within the first seven days). The potential benefit from ECMO should always be weighed against the risk of transfer.

The basic components of a VV ECMO circuit are an inflow cannula that drains deoxygenated blood from the patient and an outflow cannula that returns oxygenated blood to the patient, a centrifugal pump that circulates blood to and from the patient, and a semipermeable membrane (also referred to as “membrane lung” or “oxygenator”), in which oxygenation and decarboxylation occur (fig. 1).

The ECMO machine pumps blood from the patient's body to an artificial lung

(oxygenator) that adds oxygen to it and removes carbon dioxide. Thus, it replaces the function of the person's own lungs. The ECMO machine then sends the blood back to the patient via a pump with the same force as the heart, replacing its function.

What is ECMO?
