Bring Him your needs and the needs of others. Thank Him for His promises. Grow with Other Christians As a member of God's family, fellowship in a local church is important for your spiritual growth. Ask God to lead you to a church where you can learn from the Bible and share in worship and prayer and service. When considering a suitable church, look for one which teaches that the Bible is God's Word, our final authority, and that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, who died and rose again for our salvation. Make Christ Lord of Your Life Turn from sin. Jesus Christ is your new Master. He has freed you from

slavery to your sin nature. You will still be tempted to sin, but now you have the supernatural power to resist it. Daily discover more of His power by asking God to cleanse you from sin and empower you with His Spirit. Victory over sinful thoughts and habits will not come automatically. Walk by faith and obedience, and you will learn how to please Him. Pray often. Prayer is your lifeline to God. Talk with God throughout the day. Take all your problems to Him.
