Leafhoppers and Planthoppers There are over 12,500 varieties of leafhoppers and planthoppers, that feed on the sap from plants, grass, and trees but most are harmless to the plant. The planthopper gets its name because of its resemblance to leaves and other plants of their environment and from the fact that they often hop like a grasshopper.

Many leafhoppers and planthoppers, and some psyllids, are important pests of crop plants, particularly because they are vectors of virus, bacteria and phytoplasma diseases. Around 200 species are already known to spread plant disease but many more are likely to be recognised. However, few comprehensive identification guides are available and details of pest species are mostly widely scattered in the specialist literature.

Leafhoppers are one of the most abundant groups of plant feeding insects in the world with leafhopper and planthopper species outnumbering that of all species of birds, mammals, reptiles, and amphibians combined! Many species are host specific with their names indicating their preferred host; e.g. rose leafhopper, grape leafhopper, potato leafhopper, etc. Leafhoppers are

wedge shaped and vary in color depending on species.

Leafhoppers and planthoppers are sucking insects that remove sap from the xylem and phloem tissues of the plant. High population infestations severely damage plants. Hopper damage is called "hopper burn" because plants dry up and take on the orange-yellowish to brownish appearance of plants that have been damaged by fire.

The leafhoppers are a large and diverse family of sap-sucking, hopping insects. In overall body form, many look a lot like cicadas — only much smaller! You can distinguish them from similar groups of small hoppers by the hind legs, which have 1 or more rows of small spines on the hind tibiae ("shins").

Sweep netting, vacuum sampling, sticky traps, Malaise and light traps may all be used to sample leafhoppers, planthoppers and psyllids. But all these methods have the disadvantage that you may learn little about the host plant. It is possible to sweep or vacuum from individual plant species.

The Auchenorrhyncha are part of the Hemiptera ('true bugs') and include insects commonly referred to as leafhoppers, planthoppers, froghoppers, treehoppers and cicadas. Almost 400 species have

Because this is a large and diverse group, planthoppers may best be identified by determining that they are not treehoppers, leafhoppers, or spittlebugs/froghoppers: Treehoppers have an enlarged

pronotum (shieldlike part just behind the head) that extends backward to cover the abdomen; often it is shaped to resemble a thorn or wart on a twig.

Planthoppers form the large, diverse superfamily Fulgoroidea, with 12,000 described species placed among 20 families: Acanaloniidae, Achilidae, Caliscelidae, Cixiidae (including Achilixiidae), Delphacidae, Derbidae, Dictyopharidae, Eurybrachidae, Flatidae, Fulgoridae, Gengidae, Hypochthonellidae, Issidae, Kinnaridae, Lophopidae, Meenoplidae, Nogodinidae, Ricaniidae, Tettigometridae, and Tropiduchidae.
