Walrus (Odobenus rosmarus) ivory, from the Arctic and Subarctic seas, was much appreciated in northern Europe and the British Isles throughout the Middle Ages and was a sought-after substitute for elephant ivory when the latter was in short supply. Similarly, whalebone was occasionally used as an ivory substitute

because the larger pieces could approximate the breadth of African elephant dentine, but the more porous material was less amenable to carving and retained a matte surface.
