Sound familiar? In *The World of the John Birch Society*, author D. J. Mulloy reveals the

These tactics included organized dissemination of broad-based accusations and innuendo, political brinksmanship within the Republican Party, and frequent doomsday predictions regarding world events. The Society has seen its influence recede from the high-water mark of 1970s, but the organization still exists

today. Throughout The World of the John Birch Society, the reader sees the very tenets and practices in play that make the contemporary Tea Party so effective on a local level. Indeed, without the John Birch Society paving the way, the Tea Party may have encountered a dramatically different political terrain on its path to power.
