1 Aug 17 17:42. ASCE 7-10 and the 2012 IBC use ultimate wind speeds. In ASCE 7-10 "Table C26.5-6" shows that to convert 7-10 speeds to 7-05 speeds, you divide the 7-10 (ultimate speed) by sq.rt. 1.6. In IBC 2012 the equation provided to convert to Vasd, is to multiply the 7-10 (ultimate speed) by sq.rt. 0.6. Am I correct in thinking Vasd is the same as ASCE 7-05 design wind speed?

Converting Wind to ASCE 7-05 from Ultimate - Structural ...

In the United States, the wind speed used in design is often referred to as a "3-second gust" which is the highest sustained gust over a 3-second period having a probability of being exceeded per year of 1 in 50 (ASCE 7-05, updated to ASCE 7-16). This design wind speed is accepted by most building codes in the United States and often governs ...

In ASCE 7-10 this factor goes to 1.0. Wind load is a function of wind speed squared, so effectively a factor of 1.6 on wind load is about 1.26 on wind speed. If you multiply that times the ASCE 7-05 wind speed map you get about the same speeds as are on the ASCE 7-10 map.

What does the wind speed increase in ASCE 7-10 mean for ...

In ASCE 7-10; the wind speed maps are based on the ultimate design 3-second gust values. The minimum wind speeds from ASCE 7-10 that are equivalent to ASCE 7-05 wind speeds used in the designated catastrophe area are as follows: Inland II- 143 mph; Inland I- 155 mph; and Seaward- 168 mph.
