There are many deceivers (1 John 2:26). Leaders must raise up those who can "give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it." (Titus 1:9). We are required to "continue in the faith, stable and steadfast" (Colossians 1:23). We are urged to "attain to the unity of the . . . knowledge of the Son of God . . . so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about by every wind of doctrine" (Ephesians 4:13-14).
