This pathway provides guidance for the care of all patients who have sustained a traumatic injury with risk to life or limb. Patients with recognized life threatening injuries are classified as Trauma Level One or Trauma Level Two and require initial evaluation and resuscitation in the Trauma Bay.

This clinical practice guideline will focus on resuscitation after achieving hemostasis and will not address the issue of uncontrolled hemorrhage further. Use of the traditional markers of successful resuscitation, including restoration of normal blood pressure, heart rate, and urine output, remain the standard of care per the Advanced Trauma Life Support Course [4] .

Trauma Practice Management Guidelines

Damage control resuscitation for pediatric trauma patients is defined as an attempt to limit the use of crystalloid resuscitation, as in adults. An initial bolus of 20 ml/kg bolus of fluid is followed by 10-20 ml/kg of packed red blood cells and 10-20 ml/kg of fresh frozen plasma and platelets as part of a massive transfusion protocol.

Trauma Guidelines - Stanford Medicine

Tranexamic acid (TXA) is an anti-fibrinolytic agent that can/should be used early in the resuscitation of bleeding trauma patients. In CRASH-2 (Lancet 2010; 376: 23-32), 1g of TXA given as an early bolus followed by an infusion of 1g over the ensuing 8 hours was associated with an absolute risk reduction of 1.5%.

In severe and uncontrolled hemorrhagic shock, controlled resuscitation (MAP of 40 mmHg) is preferred [58]. International

guidelines recommend SBP of 80–90 mmHg in trauma without brain injury and MAP $\geq$ 80 mmHg in TBI until major bleeding is controlled [2].

Clinical Practice Guidelines (CPGs) - Joint Trauma System

If penetrating torso trauma, controlled resuscitation with minimal fluids until bleeding is controlled; Assess for response.
Responder: bleeding < 20%; Transient responder: bleeding

20-40%, needs blood; Non-responder: >40%, needs blood and intervention to stop internal bleeding; Consider and intervene to stop hidden sources of bleeding. Chest: chest tube

ATLS Algorithms | Pocket ICU Management

1.8.4 A senior nurse or trauma team leader in the emergency department should receive the pre-alert information and determine the level of trauma team response according to agreed and written local guidelines. 1.8.5 The trauma team leader should be easily identifiable to receive the handover and the trauma team ready to receive the information.

Recommendations | Major trauma: assessment and initial ...

Resuscitate to a MAP > 50 mmHg or SBP >70 mmHg until hemorrhage controlled. (GRADE Level of Quality – moderate; USPSTF strength of recommendation – B [intervention is recommended]) *Note: there is increasing interest in and use of resuscitative balloon occlusion of the aorta (REBOA).
