The Concerto for String Quartet and Orchestra is a composition for string quartet and orchestra by the American composer Gunther Schuller. The work was composed between 1987 and early 1988. Schoenberg provided one in the form of a string quartet. His aim in writing this concerto seems to have been to bring Baroque music to a modern orchestral audience. (In 1933 such music was very rarely played.) Schoenberg "improved" it by eliminating "uninteresting" passages and expanding other parts.
