As noted previously in this module, the colligative properties of a solution depend only on the number, not on the kind, of solute species dissolved. For example, 1 mole of any nonelectrolyte dissolved in 1 kilogram of solvent produces the same lowering of the freezing point as does 1 mole of any other nonelectrolyte.

Both solutions have the same freezing point, boiling point, vapor pressure, and osmotic pressure because those colligative properties of a solution only depend on the number of dissolved particles. The taste of the two solutions, however, is markedly different.

We are accustomed to describing a solution in terms of the concentration of the one or more solutes. However, many of the important physical properties of a solution depend more directly on the concentration of the solvent. These properties include the vapor pressure, the freezing point, the boiling point, and the osmotic pressure.

Colligative properties are properties of solutions, that depend on the concentration of the dissolved particles (molecules or ions), but not on the identity of those particles. They often affect solvent properties like boiling and melting point, or the vapor pressure above a fluid. There are four colligative properties we will look at, which are:

The colligative properties of a solution are usually considered to be: Freezing-point depression : the decrease in the freezing point of the solution, compared to pure solvent at the same pressure. Boiling-point elevation : the increase in the boiling point of a solution containing nonvolatile solutes, compared to pure solvent at the same pressure.

12.4 Colligative Properties of a Dilute Solution ...

Examples of colligative properties include vapor pressure lowering, freezing point depression, osmotic pressure, and boiling point elevation. For example, adding a pinch of salt to a cup of water makes the water freeze at a lower temperature than it normally would, boil at a higher temperature, have a lower vapor pressure, and changes its osmotic pressure.

Colligative properties include: Relative lowering of vapour pressure (Raoult's law) Elevation of boiling point; Depression of freezing point; Osmotic pressure; For a given solute-solvent mass ratio, all colligative properties are inversely proportional to solute molar mass. Because the change in vapor pressure is a colligative property, which depends only on the relative number of solute and solvent particles, the changes in the boiling point and the melting point of the solvent are also colligative properties.

The four commonly studied colligative properties are freezing point depression, boiling point elevation, vapor pressure lowering, and osmotic pressure. Since these properties yield information on the number of solute particles in solution, one can use them to obtain the molecular weight of the solute.
