A pulp author I had recently discovered is Robert Ames Bennet (1870-1954) who wrote mainly westerns and a handful of science-fiction and fantasy tales. I went after his two lost-world stories, which are not easy to find: Thyra: A Romance of the Polar Pit (1901), which was published in hardcover at the time, and "The Bowl of Baal" (1916-17), which appeared in All-Around Magazine over several issues.
